**Experiencing God:** Today's first reading from the First Book of Kings is one I mentioned in the homily last weekend. Elijah is on the run for fear of his life and reaches Horeb, the mountain of God (or Mt Sinai – different name, same place). There in the midst of the tumultuous happenings he experiences God in the 'gentle breeze' or the 'still small voice' or the silence.

The disciples are out in the boat, for they are fishermen, and this is their regular abode. But a storm brews and it rocks them. They fear they are going to drown. The Lord comes to meet them walking in the midst of the waves. With courage or bravado Peter wants to check out if it is for real.... It is all too real and again he begins to go under. But the Lord grabs hold of him and makes the move to get into the boat with them. Numerous are the ways in which we experience God. These can be a few that wash with us!

**Farewell Ritual for myself.** As part of the dismissal at each of this weekend's Mass there is a prayer (written by Marnie Niland) in thanksgiving to God for the graciousness bestowed on all of us whilst I have been here as your pastor. You also pray for God's blessing on me as I step into the deep of Jubilee. It is on the back page in the yellow shaded section if you are looking for it.

**Into Communion:** more of our young parishioners are stepping into full Communion with the Church as they receive Eucharist for the first time. Congratulations to Arielle Angwin, Spencer Connelly, Dominique Jenner, and Elijah Kenny as they receive the body and blood of Christ at the table of the Lord. This is a most significant experience of God in their lives in which we all rejoice. Thanks to their parents for the ongoing preparation of their children into the practice and love of the faith.

**Children's Liturgy:** is on today at 9.30am Mass at Christ the King Graceville. There will be water, waves and walking happening with the Word being broken open to them. Many thanks to the leaders.

**Christ the King School:** are sponsoring the 9.30am Mass and we appreciate the school children as welcomers and handing out newsletters. Also their energy and strong voices will be a powerful voice in the hymn 'These Hands.' It is on the back page of the newsletter and they need your assistance to sing it. It is "with this voice I share my love for you!"

**Farewell Feast: Lunch is on at midday today, Sunday 13th August at St Joseph's Hall.** It is a farewell to make sure I move from good ship Corinda Graceville and step out towards Jubilee. Come celebrate and tell tall stories as all good fisher-folk do! Bring something savoury or sweet to share. Most importantly, bring yourselves!!

**Walking the plank** - well not quite! Good parish stewardship sees the restoration of pews at St Joseph's Corinda. The first four have been returned in the Martindale St transept. Beautiful honey colour of the Queensland Maple shining through. Four more being worked on this week, and so it will continue for 55 pews and front-pieces.

**Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary.** "The feast originated in Jerusalem before the fifth century as the 'Falling-Asleep of the Mother of God.' It was adopted in Rome in the mid-seventh century and was renamed the 'Assumption' in the next century. It celebrates Mary's passing over, body and soul, from this world into the glory of her risen Son." *Daily Mass Book 2017*. In Australia it is a Holy Day of Obligation. A Holy Day is a solemnity celebrated like a Sunday, that is, with obligation. Mass is on in the parish at 7.30pm at St Joseph's Church Corinda.

**Going, going but not gone.** I am stepping out of this boat and into another, but the process is a slow stride rather than jumping ship! I am here in Corinda Graceville presiding at the weekday Masses. That simply means Mass is on Tuesday for the Assumption, then Wednesday, Thursday and Friday as per usual. Next weekend 19th / 20th August there will be supply priests (as I will be in Jubilee parish). Fr Mark Percival will be your parish priest from Monday 21st. Check out his bio on page 2.
